Open Burn Permit

In accordance with section 307 of the 2009 International Fire Code:

307.1 General. A person shall not kindle or maintain or authorize to be kindled or maintained any open burning unless conducted and approved in accordance with this section.

307.1.1 Prohibited open burning. Open burning that is offensive or objectionable because of smoke or odor emissions or when atmospheric conditions or local circumstances make such fires hazardous shall be prohibited.

307.2 Permit required. A permit shall be obtained from the fire code official in accordance with Section 105.6 prior to kindling a fire for recognized cultural or range or wildlife management practices, prevention or control of disease or pests or a bonfire. Application for such approval shall only be presented by and permits issued to the owner of the land upon which the fire is to be kindled.

The following conditions shall be adhered to completely; failure to do so may result in the issuance of a fine by the Fire Code Official not to exceed \$300.00 for each offense.

- * This permit is valid for a one week time period; the permit holder must contact the City of Ammon for additional extensions.
- * Burning shall be conducted during daylight hours only.
- * *Prior to burning*, the responsible party shall contact Fire Dispatch at **529-1200** and notify them when the controlled burn is to begin.
- * When all burning has been completed, the responsible party shall contact Fire Dispatch at 529-1200 and notify them that the controlled burn is finished.
- * All controlled burns shall be attended at all times; unattended burning shall be grounds for revocation of this burn permit and the controlled burn shall be extinguished.
- No materials shall be burned that would cause or create a dense smoke and/or offensive odor. The following items shall not be burned within the City of Ammon: Garbage, Rubber/Tires, Plastic and products containing plastic, Grass clippings, Animal waste, Straw, Oil, Paint, Painted or treated wood including railroad ties, Other items that may be determined out of compliance by the Fire Chief or his designee.
- * Materials to be burned must have come from the property of the permit holder; if in doubt contact the Fire Department at 612-4000 prior to burning.
- * All controlled burning shall be prohibited when wind in excess of ten miles per hour is present.
- * A garden hose connected to a water supply or other fire extinguishing equipment shall be readily available during the controlled burn period.
- * Permit holders shall adhere to burn ban periods as they are issued by the Ammon Fire Department.
- * Controlled burning shall not be conducted within 50 feet of any building or structure.

The Fire Chief or his representative is authorized to require all burning to be extinguished if it is determined the smoke emissions are offensive to surrounding property owners or other dangers present themselves that make the burn unsafe.
